



POE7 – Democratic planning and labour alliances beyond growth – Why this topic? (I)

- Worsening climate social and ecological
 - Crisis of globalization
 - Climate goals ever more illusory
- Green growth/disruptive innovation mantra increasingly tired
 - COPs increasingly disappointing
 - Involuntary degrowth?
- Emergent lines of convergence between labour struggles and ecological struggles
 - Experiments of transition 'from below'
 - Politicization of climate mobilizations

- Growth of nationalisms and populisms
- 'Radicalization' of capitalism
 - Platformization and Neo-medievalism
 - Long-termism
 - Far-right alliances
 - Where does democratic planning and new labour alliances fit in emergent scenarios or how can they affect their actualization?

- (Some) open questions
 - Historical record of planned economies
 - Urgency and participation
 - The question of sufficiency and consumption corridors
 - The relationship between forces and means of production
 - The question of class composition and of the work of nature
 - The possibility of a transition 'from below' workers' agency
 - Technocratic governance and/or politics of unpredictability and adaptation ('Gaia 2.0')
